The Position

Environmental Scientists perform program research, planning and development, permitting, compliance monitoring, inspections/enforcement, and technical support services in relation to air, water, waste, federal facilities, corrective action, mining, biology, and other environmental programs.

Incumbents possess a degree of knowledge and proficiency sufficient to perform advanced-level work and may provide work direction and training to others.

This position is located in Las Vegas, within the Environmental Services Division. Incumbent will be responsible for conducting desert tortoise, wildlife, botanical, habitat surveys and studies; preparing biological assessments for the Endangered Species Act; monitoring construction activities, developing suitable mitigation to address impacts, and ensuring compliance with permits and other biological commitments; and securing State and federal permits in conformance with the Endangered Species Act and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). This position requires in state travel (up to 50% of the time). Women and under-represented groups are encouraged to apply. To Qualify:

In order to be qualified, you must meet the following requirements:

Education and Experience (Minimum Qualifications)

- Bachelor's degree in the physical, natural resource or life sciences, engineering or closely related field and three years of professional environmental experience which involved environmental

program research, planning, and technical support; OR one year of experience as an Environmental Scientist II in Nevada State service; OR an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Additional Position Experience

- This position requires experience with the Mojave or Sonoran Desert Tortoise.
- This position requires plant and wildlife survey experience.

The Examination

Application Evaluation Exam

The exam will consist of an application evaluation. It is essential that applications include detailed information with time frames regarding education and experience. The most qualified applicants will be contacted by the hiring agency for interview. The hiring agency may require specific skills related testing as part of the interviewing process.

The following additional questions are part of this Recruitment

- 1) How many days/hours experience conducting tortoise clearance surveys do you have?
- 2) How many tortoise awareness trainings have you presented?
- 3) Provide the total number of miles/kilometers walked conducting tortoise survey transects?
- 4) Specify the total time (total hours or total number of 8-hour days) spent for all desert tortoise related field activities including those referenced above.
