Responsibilities would include conducting and/or leading surveys for desert tortoises, migratory birds, non-native/noxious weeds, rare/protected plants, and other natural resources. Would include oversight and management of mitigation implementation, monitoring compliance with mitigation for construction projects, collection/management of data, and development of biological resource reports and other environmental documents under the supervision of a Project Manager and/or Senior Biologist.
